#### Important Notes for Campers

#### **General Behavior**

As an exchange student/camper, you are an ambassador representing your country. Be attentive, courteous and considerate with your fellow Campers, Camp Leaders, and Hosting Families.

#### **Travel Documents**

Please make sure that your passport is kept safely with you at all times. As your Visa to China is only for one time entry, please refrain from using that before our trip to Luoyang on 14th June 2019.

#### **Arrival and Pick up**

Campers will be picked up at the Hong Kong International Airport by their hosting families. Should there be any queries, please call Lion Pauline Wan at (852) 9488-1469 or Lion Pappy Au at (852) 9128-0894.

#### **Health & Special Need**

Please make sure you alert the Camp Leader or your Group Leader in advance if you are allergic to any food or cannot afford to intense sports. Most important, please report immediately to us if you are not feeling well and sick, especially if you have fever, as you might be required to undergo series of medical test before you are allowed to enter into the country of visit.

## What to Wear and Bring

You will be given three (3) Camp T-Shirts at the time of registration. You are required to wear the Camp-T during group outings especially when taking the Jetfoil to Macao on 23<sup>rd</sup> June, high speed train to Luoyang on 14<sup>th</sup> June. This is for the sake of clear and easy identification when travelling in a big group.

The International Night will be held on evening of 21<sup>st</sup> June and you will be invited to do a presentation on your country. We reckon you wear your national costume or something representing your country at the occasion.

The weather in Hong Kong, Macao and Luoyang will be quite hot during the month of June (26°C to 34°C), we would recommend you to bring along light clothing, T-shirts, shorts and pants but prefer not too sexy. Please bring a light overcoat / jacket / windbreaker as the air-conditioning in most of the indoor area are quite cool or even cold and freezing. However, as there will be occasions when you have to dress properly (at least smart casual) when attending dinners and functions of a more formal nature, you are reminded to bring trousers, T-shirt with sleeves, shirts, decent dress/skirts as you reckon appropriate.

There are lots of outdoor and sports activities including dragon boat practice. Please bring along your swimming suit, swimming cap, comfortable walking shoes for running, sports shoes, hats, sunblock and insect repellent spray etc.

To protect our environment and save the world, please bring along your own water bottle. Remember to bring whatever medicine, vitamin or supplement which you are required to take.

#### Your stay with your Hosting Families

You have been assigned to hosting families which information has been provided to you earlier. We would appreciate if you could be respectful, responsible, cooperative and considerate during your stay with them. Please try your best to communicate with them in all aspects of your life back home, your interest, hobbies, family, culture etc.

Your hosting familiy has the responsibility to ensure that you are reasonably safe when staying with them. You must be aware that you will not be allowed to go out on your own without the consent of your hosting parents. Even if you are permitted to go out, you must return home per time specified and you will be solely responsible for any accident or damage due to your contrary act.

#### Smart Card in Hong Kong - "Octopus Card"

The use of "Octopus Card" is very convenient as it could be used not only for all public transport including buses, MTR, but also convenient stores, café, fast food chain stores, likewise 7-eleven, MacDonald, Starbucks, Mannings etc.

Your hosting family will give you an Octopus Card with an initial value of HK\$300 and could be top up by yourself as and when necessary. Please return the card to your hosting family when you leave Hong Kong.



#### Gifts and Souvenir

It is suggested that you bring with you small presents of nominal cost from your country as giveaways and souvenir to fellow campers, host families and officials of Lions Clubs.

#### <u>Currency/Money Exchange</u>

Hong Kong Dollars is accepted in both Hong Kong & Macao but the use of RMB is required in China. Exchange for Hong Kong Dollar and RMB could either be arranged through bank or the money exchange stores located at various locations within the city of Hong Kong.

## Rules and Regulations for Campers at Campsite

- 1. Any languages other than **English** are prohibited.
- 2. Campers are **not allowed to enter the rooms of the opposite gender**.
- 3. Alcoholic drinks, gambling and smoking as well as any activities that are against the law of Hong Kong, Macao and China are prohibited
- 4. Campers are not allowed to leave their teams without the permission of Camp Leaders /Camp Directors.
- 5. Campers should wear appropriate clothing, bring your own towel and toiletries for use at camp sites in Hong Kong and Macao.
- 6. Campers are responsible for the safety of their personal belongings and property. The organizer (including Lions, Hosting Families and Leos) are not responsible for any loss or damage.
- 7. All problems and emergency needs should be reported to Camp Team Leader and Lion on duty.
- 8. Each Camper will be responsible for making their own beds and keeping their rooms clean. Please help keeping the Camp area clean at all times.
- 9. Clean the table and clean up including dish washing after each meal.
- 10. Campers should take care of the equipment and facilities provided by the Organizer. Campers are responsible for any loss or damage.
- 11. **Do not move or damage furniture and facilities** within the campsite. Campers are responsible for claim from parties on any loss or damage due to such misbehavior/
- 12. Campers should behave themselves, respect others and follow the instructions of camp staff avoid hurting others' feelings by means of foul language or jokes.
- 13. Wearing only underwear or pajamas are not allowed in public area or in common area.

## Rules and Regulations for Campers at Campsite (cont....)

- 14. Campers are not allowed to invite friends or guests to enter the campsite or join camp activities without the permission of camp staff.
- 15. **No activities** are allowed **after 11 p.m**.
- 16. Reading materials with violent or sex content are strictly prohibited.
- 17. Campers and visitors are responsible for their own personal safety and property. Campsite would bear no liability for any injuries or loss of life of any campers and visitors.
- 18. All Campers are expected to follow the above rules and encourage others to do the same. If campers break the rules, camp staff has the authority to send you out of the campsite.
- 19. You will be reminded of the activities arranged on the following day during the dinner session of the preceding night, please pay attention and pack appropriate clothing for the next day.
- 20. All campers must report and/or gather at the assembly point promptly as any delay will create unnecessary disturbance to the camp activity as well as inconvenience to other campers.

Lions Youth Camp and Exchange Committee reserves the rights to amend activities and arrangements; and the rights of stop camper(s)'s activities due to inclement weather, ad hoc circumstances and in case of dangerous circumstances.
